I would like to begin by saying “thank you” to everyone who prayed for the health of my parents. They both have recovered from COVID and have regained most of the strength that was lost as a result of the sickness. Praise God for healing!

The Next Step Youth Sunday School Class has continued now for seven weeks, and we have seen seventy-two different Ugandans attend with our highest attendance being thirty-three! Currently, we are teaching through the “Let’s Get to Work” Sunday school curriculum from NV Publications and encouraging our class to read through the Bible in six months. Our big prayer request for the class is our follow-up program. Visitors are attending every week, but we are struggling to retain them. Even through the challenges, we are grateful that we can learn how to minister to Ugandans who are our age.

Another answer to prayer this month is that we have found a language instructor, and we will begin our Rutooro language training on February 7th. Please pray for wisdom for our instructor and patience for us as we begin our language studies. Our classes will be held three days a week for a total of twelve hours. While we are in training, Carson will be attending the nursery school at Gospel Light Baptist School. This is a big step for him and us, and we appreciate your prayers as we all adjust to this new schedule.

In the month of January, Abbey was able to begin involvement in ministry in two areas. Along with a college young lady, she was given the opportunity to help start a kids club that meets during the Wednesday evening service. In addition, she has been able to accompany the pianist by playing her violin during the congregational singing.

At the end of January, we attended our first BIMU (Baptist International Missions Uganda) Field Conference. It was a blessing to meet most of the BIMU missionaries serving in Uganda as well as hear great preaching from some guest speakers. While at the conference, Abbey had the opportunity to meet and witness to a man named Moses. Though he was eager to listen, he was not quite ready to accept Christ. Please pray for his salvation!
