God continues to open doors that we could not have foreseen when we arrived at the end of last year. Not long ago, we informed you of the salvation of our language teacher's mother and sister. At the beginning of last month, we were able to do a discipleship lesson about baptism with Ms. Lois' mom before she returned to Fort Portal. Additionally, we had the privilege to present her with a copy of the correct Bible. She adamantly told us that we needed to get to Fort Portal as soon as possible to teach others about the truth which only increased our desire to begin our ministry there.

In the middle of July, we were finally able to purchase a refrigerator and a washing machine. With the increasing costs around the world and the constant finances needed to repair our vehicle, we had not been able to purchase any appliances or furniture until now. Though we are still in need of funds to purchase furniture for our home, we are trusting the Lord to continue to supply every desire and need.

At the end of July, Ms. Lois completed the Foundations of Faith discipleship program, and she is very excited to begin the chronological Bible teaching this month. It has amazing to learn how few Ugandans know Bible stories and Bible character profiles. Over the course of the twenty lessons in discipleship, Ms. Lois became curious about stories of which she knew little, but her growth has been indescribable. She is witnessing to family and friends, challenging people about their Bible versions, learning godly hymns, prioritizing godly dress standards, and distinguishing between right and wrong music. God's power truly changes lives!

Thank you for praying for Abbey's health. We received a good report from the doctors this past week. Thankfully, she will not need surgery at this present time. The results from the blood tests were negative which allowed the doctor to rule out a blood clotting issue. Although there can be no certain answer for why the miscarriages occurred, we are confident that we have received a possible reason and that the problem can be monitored and fixed should the Lord allow us the opportunity to conceive again.

Please pray for the following requests during the month of August:

- 1. Increasing costs.** As mentioned above, we are in need of funds to be able to purchase furniture and to continue repairing our vehicle. We are learning the wonderful joys of dealing with inflation in Africa. The cost and unavailability of our vehicle have become quite frustrating as well as the constant increases in the cost of everything here. God has continued to provide the finances needed through His people, and we pray He will do that again.
- 2. Salvation of Zoe and Lilian.** Zoe was mentioned in our last prayer letter, but we have not had the opportunity to speak with her directly. Beginning next week, she will be on break from school and able to accompany her mom to our home. During this time, our prayer is that Abbey would have the opportunity to speak with her and explain salvation clearly. Lilian, Ms. Lois's cousin, has requested to do discipleship via zoom. Please pray that we would be able to find a time to witness to her and that she would understand and accept God's gift of salvation.
- 3. Growth in our son's life.** Carson is growing physically and mentally every day. He already knows the first twelve books of the Bible, many Bible verses, and several godly songs. Please pray that he will continue to grow as he should and that someday soon he will recognize his need for Jesus as his personal Saviour!
