This experience has given us even more anticipation for the future that God has planned for us in Fort Portal!

Additionally, at the end of the month, we returned to Kampala to attend our BIMU Field Conference where eighteen different family units gathered for a time of fellowship, rest, and preaching. This year, we had the privilege to hear from our field director, Bro. Eric Bohman, and a guest speaker, Pastor Scott Hanks. Having had the opportunity to build friendships with many of the missionary families here in Uganda over the past year, we enjoyed the time together.

We are beginning to get involved in the Kasese Independent Baptist Church with Missionary Matt Stensaas. Please continue to pray that we would have opportunities to grow and learn from this veteran missionary as we seek to serve God among the Batooro people.
